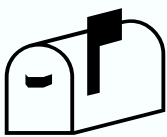

Full Membership



PEN Center USA consists of over six hundred published authors (Full members), as well as a number of burgeoning writers (Associate members), and students who support our mission (Student members). All members share a commitment to the betterment of the literary community and advocacy of the freedom of expression both internationally and domestically. The annual dues of membership, which vary by type, provide significant financial support that allows our members to carry out the work of PEN Center USA. Additionally, they grant a crucial endorsement that gives our center the authority to advocate on behalf of all writers, wherever they are imperiled.

Full membership to PEN Center USA is open to professional writers, journalists, editors and translators who have a published body of work. Anyone interested in becoming a Full member must submit an application in addition to a résumé of published work and the Full membership fee of \$79. The membership committee meets to determine whether the writer is eligible for Full membership. Applications are accepted throughout the year.

Associate, Student & Bookseller Membership



Associate and Student memberships are open to individuals who support the work of PEN Center USA. Individuals interested in becoming a member should fill out an application with current contact information, as well as the annual membership fee of \$50. Students currently enrolled in classes at any institution receive a significant discount in membership dues. They are required to pay only \$25 per year.

Recognizing the vital role of booksellers in a thriving literary community, PEN Center USA has created an affordable annual membership for any individual able to prove current employment through a bookstore, distributor, or publishing house. The bookseller membership offers event notification and access; a subscription to member publications; RAN network notices; and discounts on workshops. PEN Center USA plans to form a membership committee in 2011, dedicated to quality programming for booksellers.

LITERARY AWARDS FESTIVAL CASH PRIZE / COST: \$1,000 EACH

PEN Center USA presents the winners of the Literary Awards with a check for \$1,000 to celebrate their hard work. Fund the cash prize for one of the literary genres for \$1,000/each. 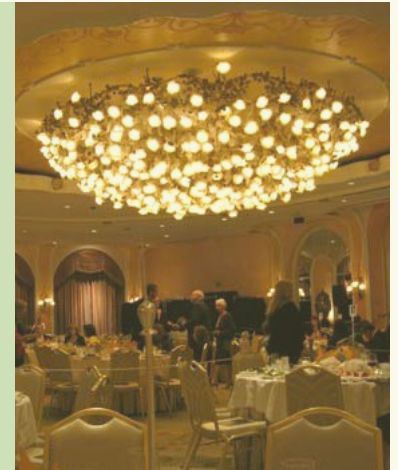
LITERARY AWARDS FESTIVAL PROGRAM BOOK COST: \$500 (PART); \$4,500 (WHOLE)

The Literary Awards Festival Program Book is a significant and lasting component of the event. The book offers attendees a program of the evening, including photos, biographies and excerpts from the work of the award winners and honorees. Underwrite part of the production of the book for \$500, or the entire publication for \$4,500. Donors at the \$500 level will receive a special Thank You in that year's program book. For \$1,000, you can sponsor a PEN USA Literary Award. 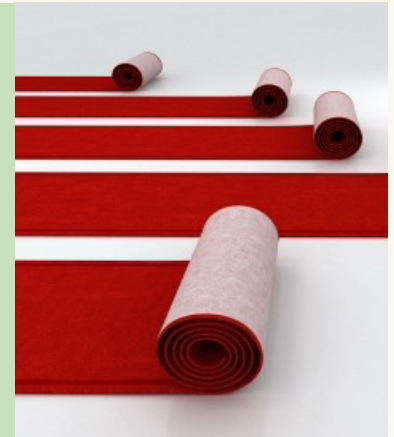

Pen In The Classroom

Since 1995, PEN in the Classroom (PITC) has helped thousands of Southern California high school students discover the power of their unique voices by sending professional writers into their classrooms for creative writing residencies.

SPONSOR A PEN IN THE CLASSROOM RESIDENCY



• The PITC program sends professional writers into public school classes for a 12-week creative writing residency. PITC Instructors are carefully selected from our membership of local writers with diverse backgrounds. They are asked to develop an original, genre-specific curriculum of in-class writing workshops which combine selected readings with classroom discussions and thematically linked writing exercises. Stipends cover the basics of preparation and classroom time, but PITC Instructors bring the inspiration for free! By supporting these visiting writers, you are playing a vital role in sharing the importance of language and the transcendent quality of words with the next generation of budding writers. Sponsor an existing residency or provide the means for initiating a new program in a school near you.

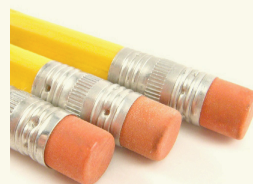

Each residency concludes with the publication of a student anthology which collects the student work created during the workshops. Seeing their work in print gives new levels of confidence to a student writer. Emerging Voices Fellowship

Emerging Voices is a literary fellowship program that aims to provide new writers, who lack access, with the tools they will need to launch a professional writing career. Over the course of the year, each Emerging Voices fellow participates in: a professional mentorship; hosted Q & A evenings with prominent local authors; a series of Master classes focused on genre; and two public readings. The fellowship includes a \$1,000 stipend.

EMERGING VOICES PROGRAM ADVERTISING & OUTREACH

• Each year PEN USA hopes to draw a larger, more diverse pool of talented writers interested in applying for the Emerging Voices Fellowship. Our outreach efforts run the gamut from stacks of postcards in local coffee shops to large print advertisements in publications like *LA Weekly* and *Poets & Writers*. By sponsoring an ad, postcard or other outreach, you are supporting this growing program's visibility to new applicants. Be an integral part in helping a struggling writer, who might otherwise be unaware of Emerging Voices, take the next step.

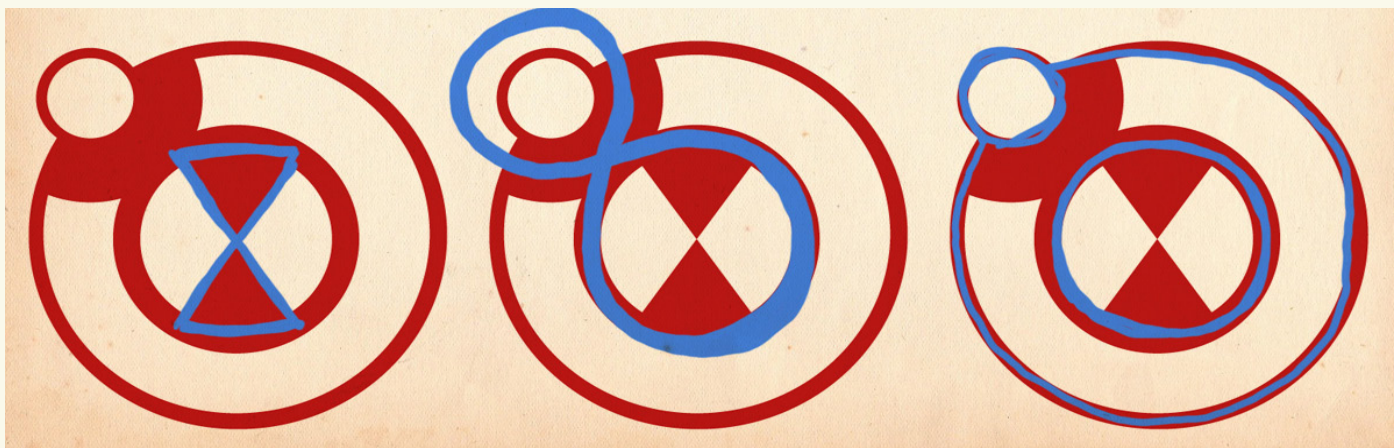
EMERGING VOICES FELLOW ENRICHMENT

• As a part of the Emerging Voices fellowship, each EV attends a series of Master classes focused on genre: fiction, non-fiction and poetry. Professional writers meet with the EVs and further their discussions on craft and the art of writing. Supporting this portion of the program provides the EVs with university-caliber classes which they would not otherwise have access to. Help fund a much needed master class with a minimum level of donation.

The Mark

The Mark is a rigorous, manuscript finishing school for Emerging Voices alumni. Project Defense, Mid-Term Review, Final Review, and Workshop are all mandatory program components.



The Mark is a rigorous, manuscript finishing school for Emerging Voices alumni. Submitted manuscripts are either completed or near completion, a page requirement of 120 pages is the minimum to apply. Upon acceptance to the Mark program, each participant will be scheduled a Project Defense, which will allow the Mark faculty and PEN Center USA staff to learn more about the participant's project. Following the defense, the Mark faculty and PEN staff will prescribe goals for the manuscript and a workshop schedule.

The Mark workshop will meet every other week, for eighteen weeks. The program also consists of a mid-term project review by the Mark faculty, which will re-address the goals set out in the Project Defense and re-evaluate the participant's progress. The program culminates in a Final Review, for which the participant will present their completed project to the Mark faculty and PEN Staff. A discussion will follow, and the Mark faculty will play a large role in regards to publishing and query advice. Donate at any level to further the publication and exposure of Emerging Voices alumni.
